Dan Gradings. Applications to the J.F.A. Inc State Grading Commissions will be dealt with on a case by case basis.

Please note: Special Needs Judoka graded with this consideration must at all times wear the J.F.A. Special Needs Judoka badge on their right Shoulder indicating their special needs when training or competing to ensure the safety to themselves and others.
