

### CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

## FOR TEAM LEADER OF COMBAT SPORTS FOR THE 2016 AUSTRALIAN OLYMPIC TEAM (BOXING, JUDO, TAEKWONDO, WRESTLING)

The Australian Olympic Committee (AOC) is taking a new approach to the roles and responsibilities of the sport Team Leaders for the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio.

Previously known as Section Managers, the newly named 'Team Leader' will be expected to manage the logistical and administrative elements of a sport's preparation and performance in the lead up to and during the Games, as well as being responsible for their team's integration into the broader Australian Olympic Team. They will be the key conduit of information flow between the Chef de Mission, Team headquarters staff and the sports themselves. At Games time, the Team Leader will be answerable solely to the Chef de Mission, and not to their respective National Federation.

In a new initiative for 2016, we will appoint one Team Leader to cover the four 'combat' sports; Boxing, Judo, Taekwondo and Wrestling. Each sport will still have their respective coaches aligned to them (dependent upon accreditations available), however the one shared Team Leader will:

- oversee the development and implementation of an administrative framework to efficiently and effectively align sports, where relevant;
- develop strong relationships with the combat sports in the lead up to 2016;
- be the sole point of contact with the AOC and Chef de Mission;
- oversee the allocation of accreditations fairly across the combat sports (in close consultation with the sports and the AOC);
- ensure an appropriate alignment to the culture and values of the Team;
- manage all behavioural aspects at Games time; and
- ensure all athletes are integrated and involved in the broader Olympic team once they have finished competing.

#### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

To apply for this position, the applicant must:

- have extensive experience in the international high performance program (eg strategy, planning, camps &/or touring) in <u>at least two</u> of the combat sports
- be able to attend the Campaign Rio High Performance Forum in Canberra from 8-10 December 2014; the 2015 and 2016 forums (dates not yet set) and any other Team Leader / Management meeting as called by the Chef de Mission
