National Selection & Points System (NSPS) Policy Review - Working Group

The Judo Federation of Australia (JFA) is seeking interest from our judo community to form a working group responsible for reviewing the requirements for a new National Selection & Points System (NSPS) Policy.

The CEO and JFA Director - High Performance will identify and appoint the most suitable candidates for this group considering a balance of experience, qualifications and gender.

Background

The international judo environment has become increasingly complex over the last 2 Olympic Cycles with a much greater focus on a World Judo Tour, World Ranking List and lengthy Olympic qualification process.

This places considerable pressure on our elite athletes to perform consistently at a high level, but it also creates greater opportunities for our junior athletes to be internationally active much sooner with the World Tour recognising a broader level of cadet and junior competitions.

Our JFA National Selection and Points System is still very one dimensional and needs to be reviewed to not only adapt to the new international environment, but also to allow for the differences between cadet, junior and senior categories.

Compositions of the Working Group

This working group will include five members:

- 1 x National Selection Committee member;
- 1 x High Performance team member;
- 1 x recently retired (in the past 24 months) athlete and
- 2 x members with extensive experience in the current Australian and international environment

Requirements for inclusion in the Working Group

Essential

- Extensive experience as athlete or support roles in the current Australian and international competition environment.
- Good understanding of the challenges faced by our athletes specifically across age categories.
- Good understanding of international competition environment.

Desirable

- Policy drafting skills and experience are preferred, but not mandatory for selection.
- Relevant experience with other judo federations, or sporting organisations

Time Commitments

- Availability of time from Oct to Dec for a series of 2-3 hour meetings (approx 3 meetings)
- Average 4-5 hours from Oct to Dec for documentation review time
- Ability to be proactive and timely with email responses
