

National Kata Committee (NKC) – Call for Nominations

Committee Type: Operational

Reporting to: Chief Executive Officer

Number of Members: Up to five, including a Chair

Eligibility Requirements

- Members of the NKC should hold a Judo grade of Fourth Dan or above. However, at its discretion the JFA can appoint a member holding a lower grade
- Nominations of individuals for the NKC must be endorsed by the Member State that the individual is registered with and resides within
- Demonstrated proficiency and understanding of:
 - Nage no Kata
 - Katame no Kata
 - Ju no Kata
 - Kime no Kata
 - Goshin Jutsu
- Ability to work as part of a group and contribute effectively
- Demonstrated capacity to effectively communicate and work collaboratively with the CEO, Member States and the broader Judo community
- Not currently be competing at National level or above

Primary Responsibilities

- Lead responsibility for development and growth of Kata nationally
- Management of Kata competitions and events
- Coordination of Kata teams for international events
- Work with Member States on Kata initiatives
- Educate National Judo community regarding International Kata updates

Key Initial Tasks

1. In conjunction with the CEO, develop a committee charter for the NKC
2. Develop and effectively communicate the NKC scope of responsibility to Members

Application Information

Nominations for a position on the NKC must include:

- Outline of relevant skills and experience
- A Judo resume
- Reason for nominating to join the NKC
- Evidence of Member State nomination endorsement
