



JVI NEWS #3 – POST MARCH TOURNAMENT 2017

March Tournament a great success!!

I think anybody that attended the first JVI Championship Tournament will agree that it was a great success. 170 people registered for the tournament, filling 195 actual entries. Compared to the inaugural tournaments of previous years, these were very good numbers. I think one of the major contributing factors to the good attendance was the number of inter-club tournaments held in the lead up to Round One of the JVI Championship. Like the AFL pre-season, it helped people prepare for the big day.

Results

The results are included in this newsletter. There are two sets of results – the JVI Club Championship results, and the JVI Schools Leagues results.

It should be noted that the JVI Club Championship results may change slightly, insofar as Volunteers –i.e. table workers, organisers and referees all earn one point each for their club. As I may not have a complete list of volunteers, the results may not yet be quite complete. The Schools Leagues results are likewise incomplete, as I was unable to confirm the school of every person who competed. Apart from the above mentioned incomplete state of the results, the overall picture is very promising. In the JVI Club Championship, four clubs performed very well, while many other clubs scored a very tidy amount of points. It seems that we will be in for a very healthy and robust championship this year!!

The Schools Leagues also look very promising. Most Leagues had around 5 schools recording points, while the top school in the State, Valkstone Primary School, scored a whopping 21 points in its first hit out as a school team. I look forward to seeing the growth of the Schools competition as the year progresses, and as more and more students step on the mat to represent their schools.

Vale John Dronryp, OAM, 7th Dan

One person sadly missing from the tournament on Sunday was one of Judo Victoria's longest serving members and referees, Mr John Dronryp. John unfortunately passed away on the weekend, leaving JVI bereft of his vast experience, his warmth and good humor. As Mr Neville Sharpe, Vice President of the JFA, knew him better than I, I have enclosed his farewell message.

VALE John Dronryp, 7th Dan, OAM and Life member of the JFA Ltd.

On Sunday the 19th of March John passed away surrounded by his family after losing a long battle with illness.

John was awarded both an OAM and a Life Membership of the JFA for his services to Judo.. He was a tireless worker for our sport as a volunteer and has been recognised by the award of a 7th Dan, degree of black belt, and the award of an honorary International Refereeing licence and a Life membership of Judo Victoria inc.

I have known John since the late 1960's when he examined me for my first grade in Judo- Yellow Belt. I have since known John as a mentor for both my coaching and my refereeing.

John has excelled in all aspects of our sport.

John was the middle weight champion of Holland before settling in Australia in the early 1960's. He then opened the very successful Bentleigh McKinnon Judo Club in 1963 where he has coached ever since. John is a charismatic figure who is very highly respected by all of his students both past and present.

John was a very successful businessman who has devoted a huge part of his life to his passion for Judo. Both John and his wife Helen devoted huge amounts of time to his club and th estate as volunteers and has made a significant difference to the lives of many young people. He has also trained many elite judo players, including many national champions. John has never lost the passion for the sport and took his wife to watch the Wold Judo championships on a regular basis.

John has been an elite national referee for over 40 years and has served as a member of both the Australian and the Oceania Referees Commissions.

John was a great mentor and friend to everyone involved in Victorian and Australian Judo.

On behalf of the JFA I pass on our deepest sympathies to Helen and family.
