# JVI Referee Commission - Roles and Responsiblities.

### Roles:

#### The JVI Referees Commission shall:

- 1. Receive all modified/new rules or interpretations as they are applied in Australian Judo through the JFA.
- 2. Be the sole authority for Refereeing in Victoria.
- 3. Determine referee grading in accordance with specified guidelines.
- 4. Authorize referee deployment for JVI, JFA and International Competitions.
- 5. Allocate referees for deployment at JVI Competitions.

## **Responsibilities:**

### The JVI Referees Commission shall:

- 1. Analyse, discuss and evaluate how, when and to what extent the modified/new rule changes shall be enforced in Victoria.
- 2. Be responsible for the dissemination of the information related to these changes to all interested referees, coaches, competitors and officials.
- 3. Be responsible for the recruitment and training of referees and their career progression.
- 4. Supervise referee application of rules and statutes as they are applied at JVI Competitions.
