Trial Membership Regulations

- 1. A trial membership is not a membership as defined in the Constitution.
- 2. There is no charge for a trial membership.
- 3. Trial membership is a precursor to an application for membership and is to give both the applicant and the JVI a chance to determine if the applicant is suitable for membership of JVI.
- 4. A trial membership is available once only.
- 5. A trial membership expires automatically after 4 weeks.
- 6. A trial member may apply for full membership at any time during or after the trial period ends in accordance with the Constitution.
- 7. The trial membership may be terminated at any time before its automatic expiry by the trial member or the JVI.
- 8. A trial membership ensures the trial member has insurance cover while participating in training sessions at a JVI registered club.
- 9. Trial membership does not allow a trial member to participate in JVI events nor to be awarded a JVI judo grade.
- 10. At the expiry of a trial membership the trial member will be sent an email with instructions on how to become a full JVI member.
