

Service Award

Preamble

JV can award a Service Award to members who have made significant contributions to Judo in Victoria over a period of 10 years or longer.

JV can award a maximum of two Service Awards per year.

Nomination process

Any JV Committee Member, Subcommittee member or affiliated voting club can nominate members for Service Awards.

The JV Life Membership nomination subcommittee will assess the nominees and make recommendations to the JV Committee.

The JV Committee will make the final decision and recommend the awarding of service awards at the AGM.

At the AGM, Service Awards will be granted using a simple majority vote.

Criteria

The Service award can be given to members for service on:

- JV Committee or Sub Committees
- State Coaches
- State Managers
- Referees
- Contribution to the running of JV Tournaments, State trainings, camps etc.

Recognition

- Awarding of Service Awards at the JV Annual General Meeting.
- Recognition of service awards at major JV events, on social media, in the newsletter and on the website.
- Award of a Service Award badge to be worn at JVI tournaments and events
