

JVI Grants for Elite & Emerging Players

Judo Victoria is proud to support elite and emerging athletes by provision of financial assistance across two performance levels and to assist in the purchase of essentials (judogi, clothing, meals, and travels).

GOLD: Elite Athlete (Seniors) – Olympic and Paralympic, National open age squad – up to \$1000 per annum

Silver: Emerging Elite Athlete (Juniors & Cadets) – Fringe Olympic and Paralympic Selection, National under age squad – up to \$750 per annum

The grant has three funding categories:

- Category 1 Participation Grant of up to maximum of \$1000 (\$750 for travel to competition or training and \$250 for essentials) for Seniors
- Category 2 Participation Grant of up to maximum of \$750 (\$500 for travel to competition or training and \$250 for essentials) for Juniors and Cadets
- Category 3 Essential Grant of up to maximum of \$250 assist in the purchase of judogi (IJF approved), contributions to foods while in program, assistance with cost of travel to training sessions.

Applicant Criteria

- Financial member of JVI
- Evidence representation in the sport and nominated event
- Must achieve a successful record in judo
- Grants will be provided either sport within Australia or travel from Australia for sporting event or overseas training camps.
- Applicant must not derive more than AUD\$10,000 per annum from other sponsorships in cash or in kind.
- If grant is used for top-up funding, amount must not exceed the maximum for \$1,000 for Seniors and \$750 for Juniors and Cadets per annum. The allocated maximum is final
- Must volunteer their services at State competitions, refereeing, and support the organisation of JVI's annual calendar of tournaments and activities.
