## **State Squad 2024 Selection Criteria**

- 1. Minimum of 70% of state squad training sessions between February and April in the prenationals training cycle. It is expected that players will attend at least 50% of the sessions in May and June.
- 2. End of Year (EoY) 2023 tournament in Dec 2023\* [3 December BALC]
- 3. A minimum of 2 JV competitions (in addition to the 2023 EoY tournament) that occur in the 12-month period between National Championships\*
- 4. The most recent MIO\*
- 5. Acceptance by the official State Team Head Coach and the State Team Manager that the candidate is suitable# for nomination to represent JV at the National Championships.

## Exemptions<sup>^</sup>

- 1. An injury has been sustained that prevented the candidate from achieving one or more of the selection criteria. Evidence required:
- a) Medical Certificate: to be sent to the Squad Manager within 7 calendar days of missing a criterion, including the period of time preventing the athlete from training/competing.
- b) Resolution process: Medical clearance to compete required and State Team Coach's confirmation (as per selection criteria) required
- 2. Ad-hoc work or schooling circumstances have arisen that prevented the candidate from achieving one or more of the selection criteria. Evidence required:

- a) Written confirmation from employer/school: to be sent to the Squad Manager within 7 calendar days of missing the criterion, including the period of time preventing the athlete from training/competing.
- b) Resolution process: Evidence of supplementary training required with sign-off from an accredited JV Coach and state team Coach confirmation required
- 3. Ad-hoc family circumstances have arisen that prevented the candidate from achieving one or more of the selection criteria:
- a) Evidence required: Written confirmation outlining circumstances to the Squad Manager required within 7 calendar days of missing the criterion, including the period of time preventing the athlete from training/competing.
- b) Resolution process: Evidence of supplementary training required with sign-off from an accredited JV Coach and state team Coach's confirmation required
- **4**. Candidate has been training / competing overseas and/or representing Australia:
- a) Confirmation by Combat Aus, Technical Director, or National Coach
- b) Resolution process: State team Coaches confirmation
- \* A points table will be used to record athletes' participation in JV tournaments leading up to the National Championships
